
Puzzle "Coordinate Education"

Instructions: Guess the words defined by the cryptic clues (answers vary in length from four to nine letters, one is foreign, three are capitalized, and one is a two-word phrase in which one of the words is abbreviated), then enter them in the grid one after another in the same order as their clues, starting in the upper left corner. Across words that don't end at the right continue on the next row, and down words that don't end at the bottom continue in the next column. Eight across words and seven down words won't fit in the grid unless one of their letters is removed. Those fifteen letters, taken in order, spell a three-word phrase related to the mystery entry.
